# NMFR Joint Finance & Personnel Committee Meeting Minutes March 22, 2022 – 5:30 p.m. City of Neenah – Hauser Room

Present: Ald. Stevenson, Boyette, Borchardt, Grade, Sevenich and Ropella

Also Present: Chief Kloehn, DC Krueger and Director Easker

Public: Mayor Kaufert

Ald. Sevenich called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

<u>Public Forum:</u> Mayor Kaufert announced his retirement and thanked the Committee for their service.

<u>Minutes:</u> The Committee reviewed the February 22, 2022 meeting minutes. **MSC Grade/Stevenson to approve the February 22, 2022 meeting minutes and place on file, all voting aye.** 

Activity and Automatic Aid Reports: The Committee reviewed the February activity and automatic aid reports. MSC Stevenson/Grade to approve the February activity and automatic aid reports and place on file, all voting aye.

Agreement for Urban Search and Rescue Emergency Services: The Committee reviewed the memo and agreement with the State of Wisconsin to resume the Special Operations Task Force. Chief Kloehn noted we did have an agreement in the past but the contract expired three years ago. It has taken that long for the State to decide how the task force would be structured, funding, etc. MSC Stevenson/Grade recommends the City of Neenah and City of Menasha Common Councils approve the Agreement for Urban Search and Rescue Emergency Response Services from April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024, all voting aye.

Firefighter Replacement: The Committee reviewed the memo from Chief Kloehn. He noted Firefighter Berendes has given notice as he has accepted a position in Dubuque, IA to be closer to his hometown and family. He is requesting permission to hire and replace this position. MSC Stevenson/Borchardt recommends the City of Neenah and City of Menasha Common Councils approve filling the vacant firefighter position created by Mitch Berendes and move forward with hiring another firefighter to help offset the known overtime that will be incurred due to the current long-term FMLA, all voting aye.

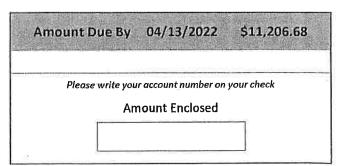

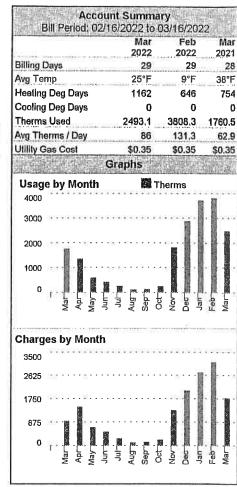

#### **ORDINANCE O-X-22**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5, CHAPTER 3, SEC. 5-3-1 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES

#### **INTRODUCED BY Mayor Merkes**

The Common Council of the City of Menasha does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Amend Title 5, CHAPTER 3, SEC. 7-2-20 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Menasha, Wisconsin as follows:

Title 5 – Public Safety

#### CHAPTER 3

Fire Prevention Code; Hazardous Materials

#### SEC. 5-3-1 ADOPTION OF STATE CODES.

- (a) Wis. Stats. §35.93 and Wisconsin Administrative Codes SPS 301 to SPS 399 Safety, Buildings, and Environment and ATCP 93, Flammable and combustible Liquids are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of the City Fire Prevention Code. For the purposes of this section, these provisions are adopted to enable the Fire Department to note any violations of such codes and to report those violations to the appropriate community service inspectors. The fire inspectors shall have the authority to cite such violations on fire inspections.
  - Overall enforcement responsibility for the provisions of this section will be equally shared by the building inspector and the fire inspector. The building inspector has the primary responsibility during construction of the building while the fire inspector has primary responsibility after the building is completed. Primary responsibility for particular sections of the above provisions shall be as indicated in the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
- (b) The International Fire Code currently adopted by the State, hereinafter "IFC" is hereby adopted as though fully set forth herein, with the following exceptions: (1) Section 105 "permits" of Chapter 1, "Administration." The most current, published edition of the International Fire Code® (hereinafter "IFC") is hereby adopted as the local use and maintenance fire prevention code as though fully set forth herein, with the following exception: Section 105 (Permits) of Chapter 1, "Administration," of the IFC is not included as part of the adoption of the IFC.
- (c) The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) codes and standards currently adopted by the State are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of the City Fire Prevention Code with the same force and effect as though set forth herein in full, unless otherwise found to be in conflict with superseding state or local codes and/or standards, then the most stringent code will apply.
- (d) Any fire prevention concern not herein addressed by code or adopted standards will be addressed on the basis of current adopted International Fire Code and/or the aforementioned National Fire Protection Association Standards.

SECTION 2: This amending Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.

Stats. § 35.93 and the Wisconsin Administrative Codes SPS 301 to SPS 399, Safety, Buildings, and Environment, and ATCP 93, Flammable and Combustible Liquids, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this article. The Fire Department may note any violations of such codes and to report those violations to the appropriate building or code enforcement officer. In addition, the Fire Inspectors shall have the authority to cite such violations when discovered on fire inspections or reported to the Fire Marshal.

Overall enforcement responsibility for the provisions of this section will be equally shared by the Building Inspector, Code Enforcement Officer and the Fire Inspector. The Building Inspector has the primary responsibility during construction of the building while the Fire Inspector has primary responsibility after the building is completed. Primary responsibility for particular sections of the above provisions shall be as indicated in the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

- (b) The International Fire Code, 2015 Edition The most current, published edition of the International Fire Code, (hereinafter "IFC") is hereby adopted as the local use and maintenance fire prevention code as though fully set forth herein, with the following exception: Section 105 (Permits) of Chapter 1, "Administration," of the IFC is not included as part of the adoption of the IFC.
- (c) National Fire Protection Association ("NFPA") Codes and Standards as the same exist on January 1, 2019, (unless stated otherwise), are hereby adopted by reference as part of the City Fire Prevention Code with the same force and effect as though set forth herein in full, unless

otherwise found to be in conflict with superseding state of local codes and/or standards. The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) codes and standards currently adopted by the State are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of the City Fire Prevention Code with the same force and effect as though set forth herein in full, unless otherwise found to be in conflict with superseding state or local codes and/or standards, then the most stringent code will apply.

- (d) Any fire prevention concern not herein addressed by code or adopted standards will be addressed on the basis of the current adopted International Fire Code.
- **Section 2.** Severability. In the event any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance. It is the legislative intent of the Common Council that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal provision had not been included or any illegal application had not been made.
- **Section 3.** Repeal and Effective Date. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

**RE:** 2022 CIP Vehicle Purchases

Due to continued delays in the heavy duty automotive market, and to help combat cost inflation, NMFR is proposing a new replacement schedule which would take effect in 2022 to secure small vehicle purchases of those set to expire or exceeding the intended life cycle for a vehicle. The purchase of Engine 31 was contracted at 17 months compared to the recent industry standard of 10 months causing the contract product not being available to deliver in '22. Starting in '23 smaller vehicle purchases are a regular part of the annual estimate and NMFR is requesting consideration to obtain small vehicles in advance of the delayed delivery by acquiring small vehicles in '22 and readjusting the long term schedule for vehicle CIP.

Due to extended lead times, heavy duty vehicles can't be obligated and received in the same operational year requiring increased contract cycles as these vehicles are currently quoting in the 22-24 month cycle, which will impact our near future large vehicle purchase of replacing Engine 32.

I am requesting consideration and action to recommend the City of Neenah and City of Menasha Common Councils approve the realignment of the CIP budget and carry forward 2022 borrowed funds remaining to apply to '23 obligations. In addition, approve actions to approve contractual obligation for a 2024 vehicle.
