#### MINUTES OF THE NEENAH WATER WORKS COMMISSION

Special Meeting – January 28, 2019 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room – City Hall

Present: President Kaufert; Commissioners: Schmeichel, Boyette, Lang; and Director Mach

**Excused:** Commissioner Smaby

Also Present: None

President Kaufert called the meeting to order at 4:37 p.m.

<u>Approve Regular Meeting Minutes for December 17, 2018</u> – Following discussion, **M.S.C.** Lang/Boyette to approve the December 17, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes. All voting aye.

Approve the Invoices for December 2018 – The Commission questioned invoices from Fischer-Ulman Construction, Inc., Ferguson Waterworks, and Digger's Hotline. Director Mach explained that the invoices from Fischer-Ulman Construction, Inc. were for concrete repairs from 2018 Water Utility construction. The invoice from Ferguson Waterworks was for a RPZ (backflow preventer) for hydrant metering hookups for contractors. Director Mach explained that the invoice from Digger's Hotline is a total charge for all locate tickets received during that month. The Utility is required to be a member of Digger's Hotline (one-call system) per State law.

Following discussion, **M.S.C. Schmeichel/Lang to approve the December 2018 invoices**. All voting aye.

Appearances - None.

<u>Approve the 2019 Wage Increase</u> – Director Mach presented the 2019 Salary Plan memo provided by HR Director Barber. In the memo, Director Barber summarizes the recommendations of the plan as budgeted by Council. Council approved the 2019 Salary Plan on December 19, 2018.

Following discussion, M.S.C. Schmeichel/Lang to approve following the City of Neenah 2019 Salary Plan. All voting aye.

<u>Award Purchase of 2019 Full Size ¾ Ton Cargo Van</u> – Director Mach presented the bid results for the replacement Meter Service Van. The Alternate Bid was explained as the difference between the Base Bid and the trade-in value of the 2008 GMC Savana 2500. Lynch Buick GMC of West Bend, WI submitted the low Alternate Bid of \$21,543.00 which includes the trade-in allowance of \$8,000.00.

Following discussion, M.S.C. Schmeichel/Boyette to approve the purchase of a 2019 GMC Savana 2500 from Lynch Buick GMC of West Bend, WI at the Alternate Bid price of \$21,543.00 including the trade-in allowance of \$8,000.00. All voting aye.

<u>Cartegraph Software Update</u> – Staff have been exploring options for the replacement of the Utility's copy of Cartegraph Software. Director Mach explained the purpose of the software is to manage Utility assets and keep a record of all service completed. The Utility projected that Cartegraph software would need to be updated in 2019. As such, the CIP reflected this as a direct replacement. Alternative systems, such as integrated GIS / Asset Management systems have become more developed. As such, Director Mach requested flexibility to include other systems including a GIS / Asset Management system. The Commission suggested issuing a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the update.

Following discussion, M.S.C. Lang/Schmeichel to allow Director Mach the flexibility to include other asset management software products such as integrated GIS / Asset Management packages to be purchased with the funds listed for the the Cartegraph Software Update CIP line item, and to create a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the update. All voting aye.

#### Director's Report -

- 1. Non-Billable Water Report (September, October, November) 10.57% up from 4.12% (August, September, October).
- 2. A memo was distributed detailing the method used to determine the non-billable water each month.
- 3. Pay Estimate No. 1 for the Towerview Drive Elevated Tank Reconditioning for \$222,730.50 to L.C. United Painting Co., Inc. Pay estimate No. 1 was approved by the Board of Public Works on January 8, 2019.
- 4. The Utility received a reimbursement from CVMIC for \$2701.34 for one-half of the cost of the new shoring equipment purchased in 2018.
- 5. The Utility received a Workers' Compensation dividend from CVMIC for \$18,442.00.
- 6. The biennial High Hazard Cross Connection Control notifications are being sent out. Compliance is required by the end of 2019.
- 7. Contract 1-19W Removal and Disposal of Lime Sludge from the east lagoon cell is out for bid.
- 8. The new Relief Operator will begin work on February 11, 2019.
- 9. Update on Claim 18-20 in the amount of \$195.87: Commission President Kaufert indicated City Attorney Godlewski has determined that this claim should be paid by the City. The City will then proceed to request reimbursement from the contractor.
- 10. The next Water Commission Meeting is scheduled for February 18, 2019.

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Storm Water Report – Harrison Street Pond – The City has prepared preliminary design for the pond. We are also exploring the purchase of the remaining residential property abutting the site to allow us additional area for the pond and additional flexibility in the design. Phase 2 environmental investigation work was completed. It identified a petroleum contaminated area in the vicinity of a former dairy that was located on the site, more or less, immediately south of the existing residential property. The investigation also identified several small surficial areas of coal and wood dust. A meeting with DNR staff is being arranged to address the proper disposition of problematic soils that will be excavated as part of pond construction.

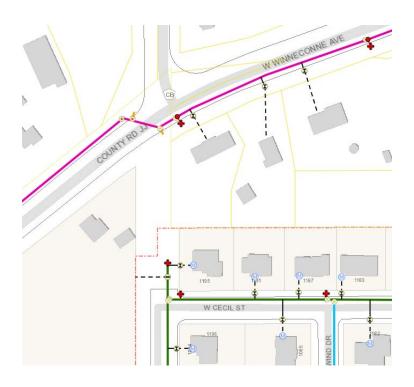

**RE:** 2019 CIP Item – Pendleton Road (Cecil to JJ)

The 2019 CIP includes a budget item for extending water main on Pendleton Rd. from W. Cecil St. to CTH JJ. Per the 2018-2022 Executive CIP, Winnebago County is planning to add a roundabout at the corner of CTH JJ and CTH CB in 2021. As such, it would be beneficial to postpone the water main extension in order to prevent interference with the roundabout construction.

Staff recommends postponing the CIP Distribution System-New Mainline Extension item *Pendleton Road (Cecil to JJ)* until 2021.
