Commissioner Morton called the meeting to order at 7:01 a.m. He noted a quorum was present.

Motion to convene into Closed Session:

It was moved by Commissioner Stevenson and seconded by Commissioner Skorlinski to convene into closed session pursuant to Wis. Stat. sec. 19.85(1)c, for the purpose of interviewing candidates for appointment to the department's police officer eligibility list.

Reconvene into Regular Session:

The Commission reconvened at 8:45 a.m. It was moved by Commissioner Stevenson and seconded by Commissioner Skorlinski to put officer candidate Holly Shoemaker on the Department's eligibility list. All voted in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Commissioner Stevenson and seconded by Commissioner Kemps to put officer candidate Jaritza Caraballo on the Department's eligibility list. The motion passed on a vote of 3 for and 2 against.

It was moved by Commissioner Stevenson and seconded by Commissioner Skorlinski to put officer candidate Adam Poepping on the Department's eligibility list. The motion passed on a vote of 4 for and 1 against.
