Kristi Branchford reported that Act 115 was passed by the Wisconsin State Legislature effective June 1, 2026, which affects healthcare decision making for incapacitated patients who do not have an healthcare directive. The action further emphasizes the importance of having a directive, which can be obtained through a straightforward process.
