Approval of Minutes of the Meetings of June 11, 2023, and August 2, 2023

Motion/Second/Carried by Hillstrom/Borchardt to approve the minutes of the Meetings of July 11, 2023, and August 2, 2023. All voting aye.

Neenah Police Department 2nd Quarter Statistics

Lieutenant Wagner and Investigator Kowalski reviewed the Police Department 2nd Quarter Statistics. They noted that calls for service were down in the 2nd quarter. They stated that one of the reasons for the decrease is the training of new officers. Unified Crime Report was reviewed. Lieutenant Amy Wagner and Investigator Paige Kowalski noted that in the 2nd quarter Crimes Against Person were 29%, Crimes Against Property were 58% and Crimes Against Society were 13%. Traffic Warnings and Citations were reviewed. Lieutenant Amy Wagner and Investigator Paige Kowalski noted that Safety Officer Edwards numbers are down this quarter because he was in training. OWI Arrests were reviewed. Lieutenant Amy Wagner and Investigator Paige Kowalski stated that there were 13 OWI arrests in the 2nd quarter. Parking Citations were reviewed. Lieutenant Amy Wagner and Investigator Paige Kowalski stated that the numbers are still low as staff gets familiar with the new parking software. Accidents were reviewed. Lieutenant Amy Wagner and Investigator Paige Kowalski stated that continue to see an increase in accidents, with the majority of them happening during the daylight hours. Overdoses were reviewed. Lieutenant Amy Wagner and Investigator Paige Kowalski stated that there have been 6 fatal overdoses in 2023. Dangerous Animals and Open Records Requests were reviewed.

Final Resolution 2023-19: Freedom Acres Subdivision 2-Inch Asphalt Mat

Director Kaiser stated that this is the final step in the assessment process.

Report

Following Discussion: Motion/Second/Carried by Stevenson/Borchardt to recommend Council approve the Final Resolution 2023-19, 2-Inch Asphalt Mat Overlay for properties served in the Freedom Acres Subdivision. All voting aye.

Final Resolution 2023-20: Homes at Freedom Meadows Subdivision 2-Inch Asphalt Mat

Report

Following Discussion: Motion/Second/Carried by Weber/Stevenson to recommend Council approve the Final Resolution 2023-20, 2-Inch Asphalt Mat Overlay for properties served in the Homes at Freedom Meadows Subdivision. All voting aye.

Public Works General Construction and Department Activity Report

- 1) Contract 7-21 (Harrison Pond): Storm and sanitary sewer work is complete, and the pond is functioning. Rock placement for the water feature needs to be completed as does the installation of the electric service. We met with the contractor to review quantity measurements and related costs. Both the wall and the water feature required a higher quantity of stone base and stone units to construct.
- 2) Contract 1-23 (Chestnut, Burr, Dieckhoff, Laudan Utility and Street Construction): Utility work is complete. Street excavation is ongoing.
- 3) Contract 2-23 (Charles, Hughes, Memorial, Patrick, Brantwood Dr/Ct Utility and Street): Utility work is complete. Concrete repairs are complete.
- 4) Contract 3-23 (Concrete Pavement/Sidewalk Repair): The contractor has started work.

Director Kaiser stated the contractor is currently working at the Tullar Rd and Breezewood Dr roundabout. He stated staff has been working with the contractor on the traffic control.

- 5) Contract 4-23 (Asphalt Repairs): The contract was awarded to MCC, Inc. A work schedule has not been set.
- 6) Contract 5-23 (New Subdivision Street Construction):
 - a) Arthur Plat: Work is complete.
 - b) Cardinal Plat: Work is complete.
 - c) Integrity Acres: Work is complete.
 - d) Liberty Heights: Curb/gutter and driveways are complete. The binder course of asphalt is in place. Landscaping is ongoing.

- 7) Contract 6-23 (Columbian Av Utility and Street Construction): Utility work is complete. Road excavation is complete. Concrete work is complete. Landscaping is ongoing.
 - e) Beaulieu Road sanitary sewer – Work is complete.
- 8) Contract 7-23 (High, River Utility and Street Construction): The contract was awarded to Carl Bowers & Sons Construction. Work is scheduled to start at the end of August. Work on several isolated sewer lateral replacements has been done from the house to the terrace. These will be completed with the project.
- 9) Contract 8-23 (Tullar Garage Office Area Roof Replacement): This contract was awarded to JT Rams, LLC. A work schedule has not been set.
- 10) Contract 9-23 (Epoxy Pavement Marking): The project was awarded to Century Fence. The contractor has completed some of the work.
- 11) Contract 10-23 (Parking Lot, Temporary Asphalt Street Construction): The project has been awarded to NEA. The proposed schedule calls for work to start the third week of August be completed by mid-September.
- 12) Contract 11-23 (Hunt, Fairwood, Brookwood Street Construction): The project has been awarded to NEA. The proposed schedule calls for work to start the third week of August be completed by mid-October.
- 13) Storm Damage: Significant storm damage was experienced on the evening of August 3. This storm marks the third time this summer that special yard waste collections were arranged to pick up damage caused by storms.
- 14) 1st Addition to Homes at Freedom Meadows: Utility work has started for this subdivision. Sanitary sewer work is complete. Water utility work is ongoing.

Director Kaiser stated that he had received the bid package for the Neenah Creek Bridge. He stated that the bid opening is scheduled for August 24, 2023.

Director Kaiser stated that he and City Attorney Raschid met with TDS regarding the escrowed funds that was set up for plan review and inspections. He stated that the funds are exhausted. Director Kaiser stated that TDS will be issuing another escrow payment.

Aldersperson Stevenson asked about the status of the pavement markings on Tullar Road by the old high school. Director Kaiser stated that staff will evaluate what is needed for pavement markings after the first year of the middle school being in that location. He stated that it will be CIP line item.

S. Commercial Street Right-of-Way Plat: Director Kaiser reviewed his memo of July 26, 2023, regarding the relocation order for the S. Commercial Street reconstruction. He reviewed the resolution and exhibits comprising the relocation order. He noted that the right-of-way plat exhibit identifies the types of land interests and areas needed. He noted that the majority of the interests are for temporary limited easements (TLEs). These are needed primarily for matching in lawn grading behind the sidewalk and, in some cases, for matching in driveways. The fee acquisitions needed are mainly for curb ramp adjustments at corners. Committee discussed the process involved in acquiring the land interests needed and the rights of the property owners. Committee discussed the timing of the work. Director Kaiser noted that all interests must be acquired before the final WisDOT review of the project plans and specifications leading up to the project letting.


Following discussion, **Motion/Second/Carried Borchardt/Weber to recommend that Council approve Resolution 2023-18, the Relocation Order for the S. Commercial Street reconstruction between Stanley Street and Tyler Street.** All voting aye.

Temporary Extension of Licensed Premises for Gord's Pub, 210 Main Street, to host a street dance on Friday, August 18, 2023, from 6-10pm in Plexus Parking Lot: City Clerk Nagel reviewed the permit application and site plan. She noted the area to be fenced and stated that only soda and beer will be served – there will be no liquor served or food trucks. The event runs from 6 – 10 p.m. Committee asked about the permission received for the use of the parking lot. City Clerk Nagel stated that the application noted that permission had been received but that a written permission had not been included with the application but that she could request that from the event sponsor. Committee discussed ownership of the lot.

Following discussion, **Motion/Second/Carried Borchardt/Weber to recommend that Council approve the Temporary Extension of Licensed Premises for Gord's Pub, 210 Main Street, to host a street dance on Friday, August 18, 2023, from 6-10pm in Plexus Parking Lot.** All voting aye.

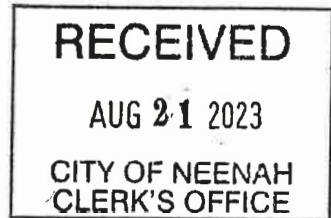
I do hold a full time job, have been with the company for over 2 years. I am looking for suplimential income and looking to help a close friend and local business on a part time as needed basis.



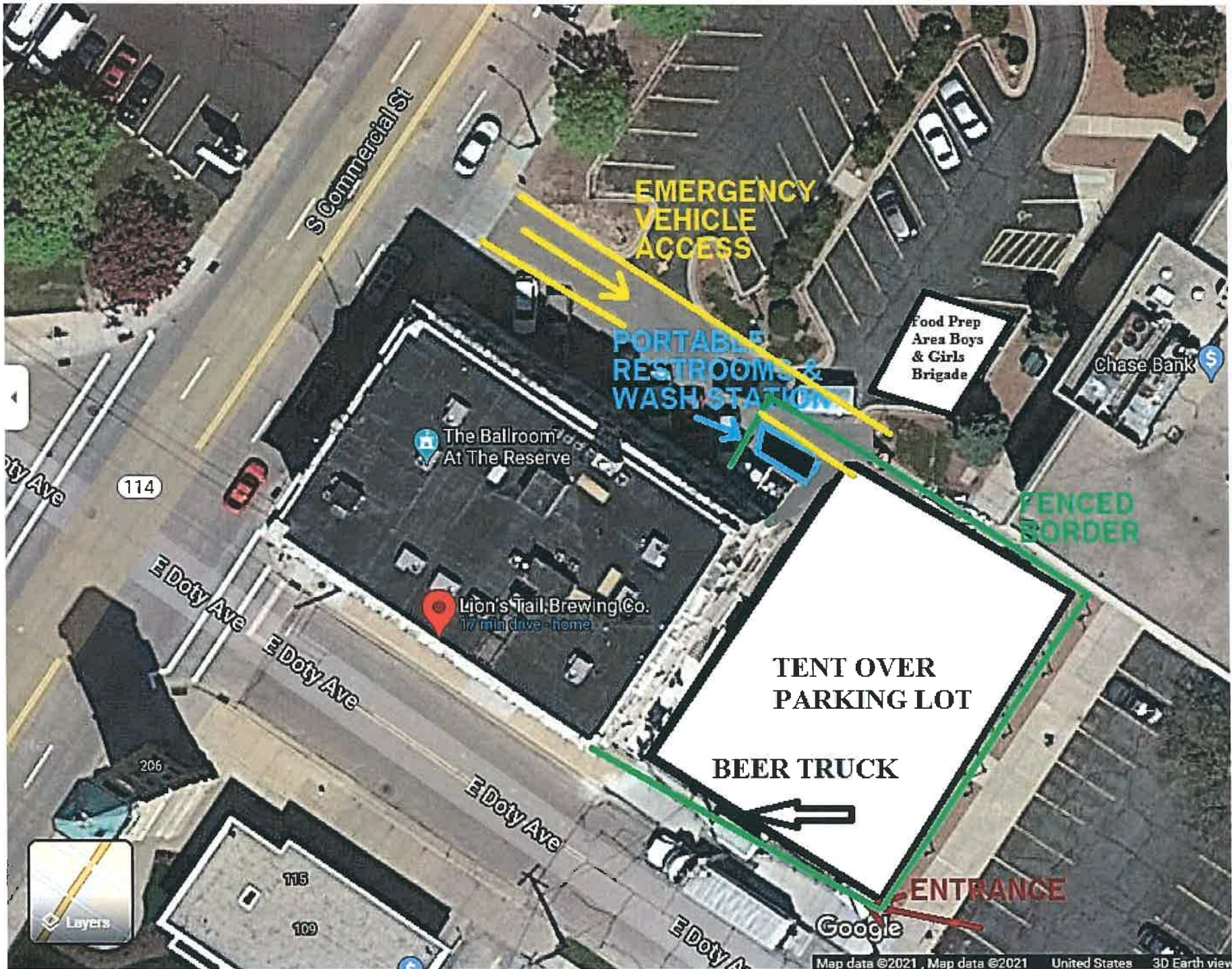

Re: Flock Cameras

In April of 2022, Flock went live in six locations throughout the City of Neenah. In that time, Flock has assisted in many different types of cases and calls for service. We currently have over 40 documented successes. Flock Alert cases range from arrests of wanted felons and recovered stolen vehicles to making contact with people that were listed as missing/endangered. Through the contacts made because of Flock, we have also been able to recover and make arrests for drugs, impaired drivers, stolen guns and other stolen items. As I was working on this memo, officers responded to a Flock Alert for a suspect in a stalking case for Appleton Police Department. This subject was located, arrested, and turned over to Appleton Police.

Officers have also used Flock's search capabilities to identify vehicles and suspects wanted in gas drive-offs, burglaries, hit and runs, fleeing and eluding and thefts through normal searches looking for a particular make and model to using the unique identifiers of suspect vehicles such as bumper stickers.

Flock has gained a lot of traction in this area which only makes its capabilities greater. Current area agencies using Flock include:

Waupaca County, Winnebago County and Shawano PD are also in various stages of entering this program.

We were informed this year that the cost of Flock will be increasing from \$2,500 per camera per year to \$3,000 per camera per year. We have until the end of the year to enter a 5-year contract for current cameras and any additional cameras to lock in at the \$2,500 per camera pricing.

With the successes that we have been experiencing from Flock, we budgeted \$21,000 for the installation of six more cameras. I worked with Traffic Engineer, James Merten to find out which roads that enter the city would capture the most traffic. From this data, the following locations were chosen:

North Green Bay Road
County Highway A

First Street
North Lake Street

Breezewood Lane
Bergstrom Road

At current costs, it is estimated that the additional cameras with install would cost \$18,400 if done this year. If we are to wait until 2024 for these new locations, we would spend \$21,400 for the first year and install. We would spend \$15,000 more over the next five years for these six new cameras.

Recommendation:

Allow the Neenah Police Department to install six (6) additional Flock cameras at a cost not to exceed \$21,000 and to allow the Police Department to enter a 5-year contract with Flock to secure pricing at \$2500 per camera for all twelve (12) cameras. The recommended funding source would be the Capitol Equipment Reserve Fund.

RE: Relocation Order for Right Turn Lane Project at the Intersection of Commercial Street & Winneconne Avenue

S. Commercial Street between Stanley Street and Tyler Street is scheduled for construction in 2025. In order to match the proposed layout for the project, a southbound right turn lane is proposed to be constructed at the intersection of Commercial Street and Winneconne Avenue. This intersection work is proposed to be completed in 2024 to maintain traffic flow during construction for the 2025 project.

The intersection improvements require the City to acquire land interests from the property at the northeast corner of the intersection. Per Wisconsin Statutes, the first step in the acquisition process is approval of a relocation order by the City. This declares the intent and purpose of the acquisitions, provides a schedule of the required interests, and drawings of the project that show those interests.

The Neenah Plan Commission and the Public Services and Safety Committee will be presented with a resolution along with the related relocation order and right of way plat attachments.

An appropriate motion would be to recommend that the Common Council approve Resolution 2023-23, the relocation order for the southbound right turn lane project on S. Commercial Street at the intersection of Winneconne Avenue.

RE: Public Works General Activity

- 1) Contract 7-21 (Harrison Pond): Storm and sanitary sewer work is complete and the pond is functioning. Work has restarted on the water feature. The installation of the electric service also needs to be done.
- 2) Contract 1-23 (Chestnut, Burr, Dieckhoff, Laudan Utility and Street Construction): Utility work is complete. Street excavation was completed 8/25. Some additional gravel will be placed and then curb installation will start.
- 3) Contract 2-23 (Charles, Hughes, Memorial, Patrick, Brantwood Dr/Ct Utility and Street): Utility work is complete. Concrete repairs are complete. Streets are being graded and graveled.
- 4) Contract 3-23 (Concrete Pavement/Sidewalk Repair): The contractor has started work. He will re-mobilize on that contract in the middle of September to complete the downtown target area and the N. Park Avenue sidewalk.
- 5) Contract 4-23 (Asphalt Repairs): The contract was awarded to MCC, Inc. A work schedule has not been set.
- 6) Contract 5-23 (New Subdivision Street Construction):
 - a) Arthur Plat: Work is complete.
 - b) Cardinal Plat: Work is complete.
 - c) Integrity Acres: Work is complete.
 - d) Liberty Heights: Curb/gutter and driveways are complete. The binder course of asphalt is in place. Landscaping is ongoing.
- 7) Contract 6-23 (Columbian Av Utility and Street Construction): Work is complete except for two asphalt driveways.
 - a) Beaulieu Road sanitary sewer – Work is complete.
- 8) Contract 7-23 (High, River Utility and Street Construction): The contract was awarded to Carl Bowers & Sons Construction. Work is scheduled to start after Labor Day. Work on several isolated sewer lateral replacements has been done from the house to the terrace. These will be completed with the project.
- 9) Contract 8-23 (Tullar Garage Office Area Roof Replacement): This contract was awarded to JT Rams, LLC. Work schedule is tentatively scheduled to start in late September.
- 10) Contract 9-23 (Epoxy Pavement Marking): Work is complete.
- 11) Contract 10-23 (Parking Lot, Temporary Asphalt Street Construction): Work on the parking lots started on 8/23. Some areas of wet soil were uncovered in the Marketplace Lot. Grading and structure adjustments are scheduled to start on 8/29. Paving is tentatively scheduled for Labor Day week.

- 12) Contract 11-23 (Hunt, Fairwood, Brookwood Street Construction): Pavement removal and concrete repairs are complete. Grading and structure adjustments are ongoing.
- 13) City Hall Elevator: Work is scheduled to start on the elevator upgrade in mid-September.
- 14) Neenah Creek Bridge: Bids were opened on 8/24. These will be reviewed by the Board of Public Works at their 8/31 meeting with a recommendation going to Council on 9/6.
