Public Appearances:

Public Health Nurse Lori Duclon discussed the new booster that will be available this fall to address the original strain of COVID-19 and recent Omicron subvariants. Lori also discussed reported that a low volume of monkeypox vaccine is available in Winnebago County for qualified persons at higher risk. Monkeypox is spread through skin-to-skin contact; persons with a rash are advised to contact their health care provider.
