Public Appearances: Tayler Roal introduced himself and briefly discussed his interest in sustainability issues.

Discussion of Education/Information projects:

Presentation by Wisconsin Salt Wise Program Manager Allison Madison:

Allison provided a powerpoint presentation regarding the Wisconsin Salt Wise program and how salt use on roads and sidewalks impacts roads, surface water and drinking water. Allison communicates with municipalities including the Neenah Street Department and supports the work Neenah does to use salt effectively and efficiently. She has suggestions about raising awareness that can be implemented at the local level, including information such as the Sustainable Neenah article in the winter 2023 edition of the Neenah Notes.

Committee members discussed participation in the 2023 Farmers Market and supported continuing the Committee's sponsorship at the \$1,000 level.
