The following officers are on probation and are in phase five of their field training: Officer Eric McLevige, Officer Christopher Olson, Officer Aidan Schwartz, and Officer Brittney Westpfahl.

Since the last meeting, Chief Olson was pleased to report that Lieutenant Jason Goetz attended and graduated from the FBI National Academy in Quantico, Virginia. The FBINA is a 10-week, accredited, residential leadership and professional development program for senior law enforcement professionals from all over the world.

Chief Olson was also pleased to announce that Lieutenant Jeremy Bauman will begin the Wisconsin Command College on September 14. This is a six-week course that meets one week per month, for six months. The Wisconsin Command College is a nationally accredited leadership and management development training program and is a joint venture of the Wisconsin Department of Justice and the University of Wisconsin - Madison. Law enforcement leaders who complete this six-week in-residence program will be recognized as a Certified Public Managers by the University of Wisconsin.
